University of Greenwich Choir

The David Fussey Choral Exhibition is open to any new or existing student who becomes a member of the University of Greenwich Choir. The exhibitions are awarded in memory of Dr David Fussey, the late Vice-Chancellor of Greenwich, who gained great enjoyment from singing in choirs and encouraging others.

The David Fussey Choral Exhibitions are offered in order to attract, encourage and enhance the student membership of the choir. Applications from tenors and basses are particularly welcome.

About the choir

The choir rehearses on Monday evenings during term-time. The choir performs in venues including the Old Royal Naval College Chapel and St Alfege Church, Greenwich.

The choir performs a wide range of music, from Mozart to musicals. Recent concerts have included Orff *Carmina Burana*, Purcell *Dido and Aeneas*, and “Songs from the Shows”.

The choir also puts on social activities, including an annual Choir Dinner, which is free to all members.



Value

There are a very limited number of David Fussey Choral Exhibitions. The exhibition is worth £1,000 per year (payable in two £500 instalments), for a maximum of three years. The exhibition is subject to renewal each year, based on the exhibitor's successful participation in the scheme.

Eligibility

All new and existing University of Greenwich students are eligible to apply. Good singing ability is essential, and previous choral experience is desirable.

Application

If your application form is received before the deadline you will be invited to attend a vocal audition in early October. If you are unsuccessful in securing the exhibition, you are still entitled to join the choir as a singing member.

Conditions

The choral exhibitor shall attend all rehearsals of the University of Greenwich Choir and give full support to the music director. The choral exhibitor shall be, in conjunction with the music director, responsible for enthusiastic publicity and general administrative tasks.
