Naomi Winstone - Everybody hurts? Sharing feedback experiences to develop students' feedback literacy

Abstract - In a recently-published model of feedback literacy (Carless & Boud, 2018), the ability to manage affective reactions to feedback is recognised as a central component. In the case of students, the literature reveals that emotive reactions are a common barrier to students' engagement with and enactment of feedback information (e.g. Jönsson, 2013; Winstone, Nash, Rowntree, & Parker, 2017).

However, these reactions are not specific to students; many educational practitioners report similar reactions when receiving feedback through peer review, or through student evaluations, for example. In this talk I will outline the role of emotion in feedback processes and explore how we can build feedback literacy within our students by sharing our own feedback experiences.
