# Where to go

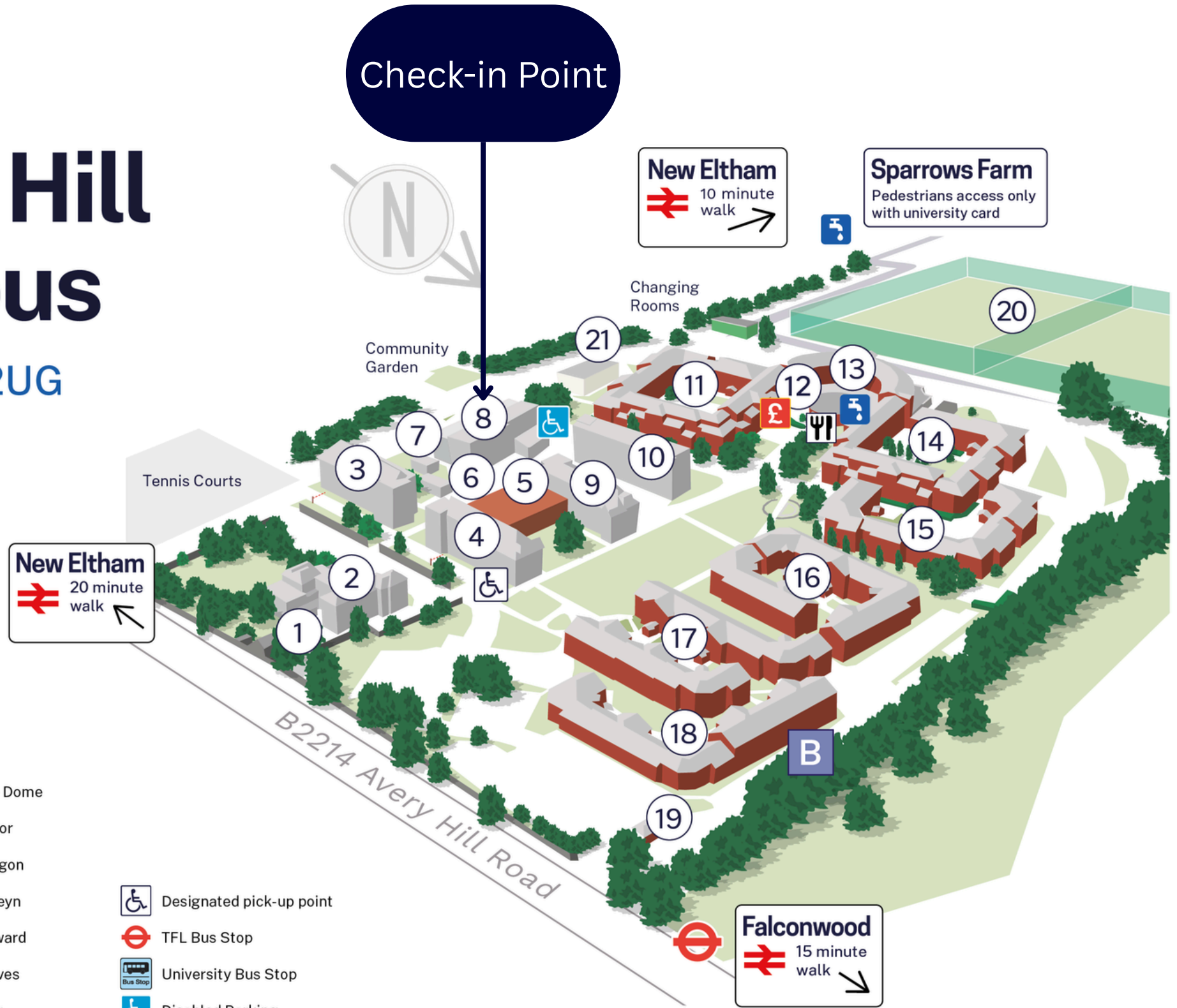
