While the specifics of the research design would be the remit of t doctoral student, we envisage this research being completed thro set of case studies in local authorities in areas where refugees hav received, for example: Kent, London, Glasgow, and Yorkshire. We envisage that data would be collected directly from refugees themselves, but rather through key informant interviews with fro operatives in various service-defined roles within one or more of aforementioned geographic areas.
