


Module Option Choice Selection for student


The Module Option Choice Selection facility allows students to select their optional modules for the next academic session prior to registration for the next academic session.

To access Module Option Choice Selection, first log into the Portal (<https://portal.gre.ac.uk>):




Then select 'Student Records' from the quick links bar at the top of the page


