## Business



University of Greenwich has achieved Planet Mark Certified - Business by reporting its measured carbon emissions, reducing Scope 1 and 2 emissions (market-based) per employee by 6.0% compared to the previous reporting period, and by committing to expand its measurement boundary to measure up to a full carbon footprint. Compared to 2024, University of Greenwich has also reduced its total measured carbon emissions (market-based) by 17.0%.
