

# GEP Points FAQs

## A. New points system and streamlined awards

To achieve the full Passport, you need to receive and earn a total of 250 points throughout your studies at the University of Greenwich. **Completing each Pathway will award you 50 points**, so to achieve the full Passport you have to complete five different Pathways. However, we encourage you to go beyond this, and complete as many Pathways as you can to achieve the maximum rewards and gain the most employability skills.

Streamlined rewards for points earned:

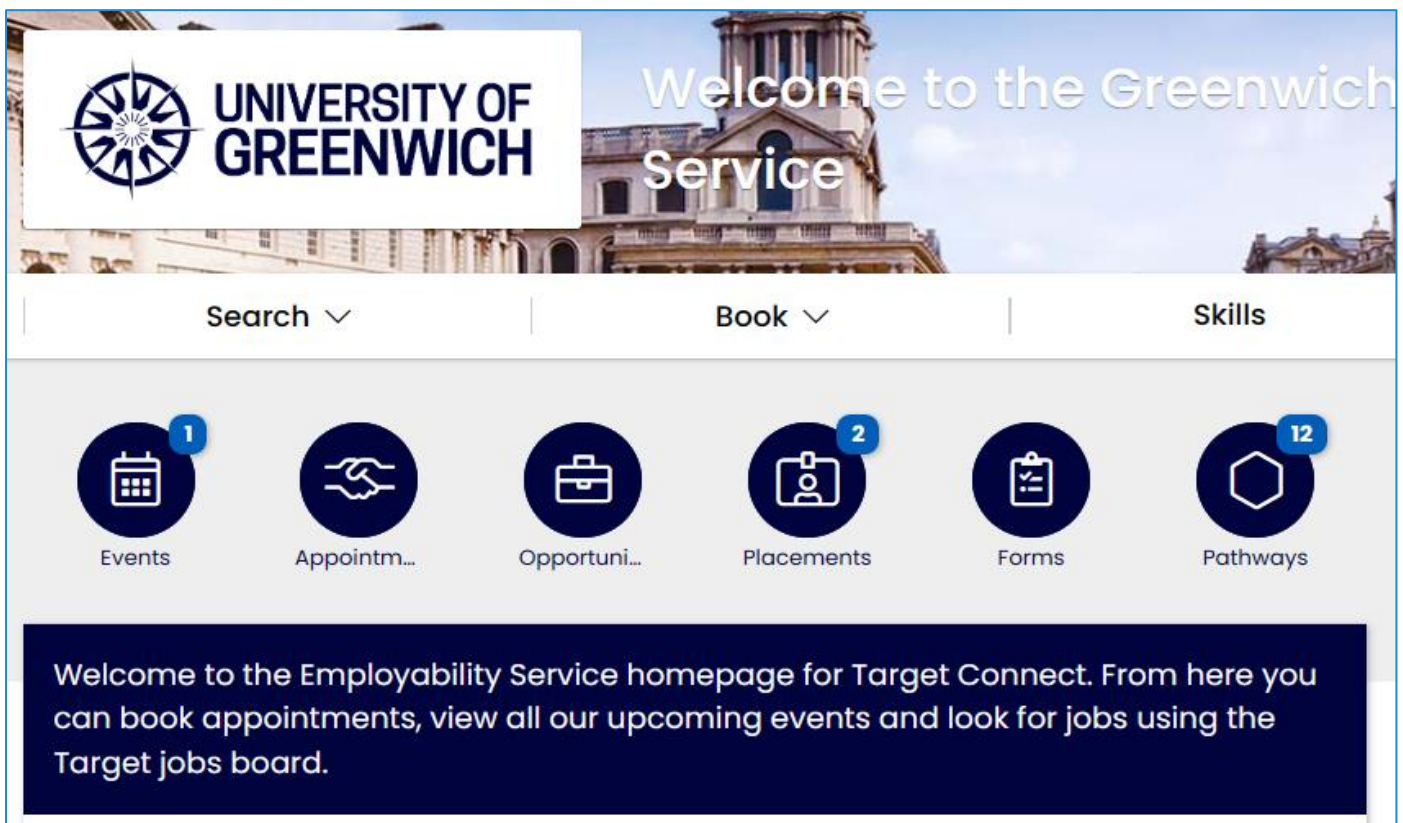
- **250 points (5 Pathways):** Greenwich Employability Passport (GEP) Certificate
- **300 points (6 Pathways):** LinkedIn Recommendation

You only get points from completing certain GEP Pathways, you do NOT get points for the **GEP - Getting Started pathway**.

## B. How do I count my GEP points?

You can easily see how many pathways you have completed by logging into Target Connect and then selecting **Pathways** in the notification bar:
