We obtain this data about you from you directly. We may also confirm certain details that you have provided to us by consulting sources in the public domain, including professional regulatory bodies such as the Solicitors Regulation Authority and the Bar Council.

We keep this data for the period of your volunteering, plus six years.

We process personal data about you for the following reasons:

- To administer and manage your role as a volunteer lawyer or caseworker;
- To provide a high quality and safe Legal Advice Centre service to clients and student volunteers.
