

Social Work Programmes entry to Year 2 & 3

Declaration of Good Character

Students are unable to attend practice placement without completing a self-declaration at the beginning of each year. Failure to do so will result in your placement being withdrawn and absence occurred. You may be required to make up this absence at the end of the programme without a bursary.

I declare that:

- I. I believe that my health and character are sufficiently good to enable me to continue on the Social Work Programme.
- II. I confirm that I have not been convicted of any criminal conviction, reprimands, on the spot fines, including been cautioned (verbally or in writing) or been bound under investigation that may have been recorded by the police. I am aware that it is my responsibility to ensure that I disclose all necessary and required information.
- III. I confirm that I have not developed a health condition or disability since interviewing for the programme that may affect my ability to practise safely and effectively.
- IV. I can confirm that I have not previously been struck off the register of a professional body for social work, nursing or an allied caring profession.
