### TERMS OF REFERENCE – 2024-2025

#### Purpose of the Forum

The purpose of the Greenwich Researcher Forum (PGR & ECR) is to:

- Support the dissemination of University strategy, policy and initiatives
- Support the implementation of the Greenwich Research & Innovation (GRI) sub-strategies
- Obtain and explore the views and opinions of the PGR/ECR community
- Enhance the PGR/ECR experience and make recommendations for achieving meaningful change
- Identify and agree suitable mechanisms for addressing matters raised

#### Deliverables

- To provide a forum for discussion and review of matters pertaining to the PGR and ECR communities
- To feed a summary of PGR and ECR matters into the University Research and Knowledge Exchange Board
- To share areas of best practice with Faculties and Directorates across the University with a view to improving the PGR and ECR experience.

The membership will be reviewed annually.

## **Secretarial Arrangements**

The secretary will be provided by RETI.

The secretary will co-ordinate meetings, prepare agendas, produce accurate minutes and monitor and report on follow-up actions.

## **Attendance**

The Chair will nominate a deputy from within the group to cover leave or unexpected absences.

Attendance by Forum members is expected at every meeting. Should a representative be unavailable to attend a meeting, their place may be taken by a designated substitute.

At the discretion of the Chair, other staff who are not members of the Forum may be invited to attend on an ad hoc basis for specific items where their attendance can inform and support the work of the Forum.

## **Member Responsibilities**

Members are responsible for:

- Attending meetings or providing a designated substitute
- Contacting those they represent to gather and bring forward valuable information for sharing/concerns for raising/ ideas for improvements
- Feeding back to those they represent and cascading information
- Providing updates on actions based on previous meetings
- Providing news on ongoing projects and initiatives

## **Communication and Collaboration Platform**

To facilitate ongoing communication, encourage continuous feedback, and provide regular updates, an online Microsoft Teams group and OneNote book is created for all members. This platform will serve as the central hub for:

- Updates: Regular updates on actions, projects, information and initiatives from faculties/directorates can be posted to keep all members informed. Members are requested to provide written updates at least 2 days prior to meetings/when there is no representation at the meeting.
- Sharing Feedback, Ideas, Matters for Discussions: Members are encouraged to share their thoughts, suggestions, and concerns in the dedicated topic page in the Forum's OneNote, ready for discussion.
- Document Sharing: Relevant documents, meeting minutes, and resources will be accessible through the Teams group.

All members are invited to actively participate in the Teams group to enhance communication and ensure the group's objectives are met.
