ISSUE: INTRODUCTION OF A NEW POLICY

SUMMARY:

A new policy is proposed, to confirm the University's position which respect to apprenticeship students and their status as students of the University. The policy outlines key policies and procedures for students, which are equally applicable to apprenticeship students who are registered for study with the University.

The Policy has had input from Planning and Statistics, Greenwich Research and Enterprise, Student & Academic Services, and Faculty representatives. The policy has been approved by the Deputy Vice Chancellor (Research and Enterprise), as the Chair of the Apprenticeship Strategy Group.

ACTION REQUIRED:

The Academic Council to approve the policy.



Apprenticeship Policy

Scope

This policy is to outline that all policies which are where applicable to students, they are applicable to apprentices.

Aim

The University of Greenwich aims for our students to receive an equitable and consistent learning experience across the whole university (Academic and Student Experience Strategy, 2018-22). The University offers a wide range of programmes for a diverse set of students, each of whom can expect to receive outstanding support appropriate for their needs. Apprentices are considered as University of Greenwich students until the apprenticeship ends.

Policy
