Key Responsibilities:

- **Sorting Donations:** Check, clean, and price second-hand donations.
- **Stock Rotation & Organisation:** Keep the shop floor tidy, restocked, and well-presented.
- **Visual Merchandising:** Design appealing displays to showcase items and improve the shopping experience.
- **Customer Service:** Greet and assist student customers in a friendly, supportive environment.
- **Taking Payment:** Handle purchases and card transactions (training provided).
- **Sustainability Advocacy:** Promote the benefits of buying second-hand and reducing waste.
- **Data Reporting:** Recording the number of items sold, donations received and (optional) support Project Manager with monthly reporting.
