

The Greenwich Bursary

The Greenwich Bursary is worth £700 for one year only, paid in two instalments of £350 for new undergraduate students entering their first academic year of study – Year 0 or 1.

Eligibility Criteria

- Undergraduate Full-time and Part-time students new to the university in 2025/26
- Studying at one of our three campuses: Greenwich, Avery Hill and Medway (except Medway School of Pharmacy) or one of our Partner Colleges.
- If studying with a Partner College, the tuition fee must be paid directly to the University of Greenwich
- Undertaking a BA/Bed/BSc/LLB/Beng/Meng or Mmath programme
- Assessed to pay fees at home rate and be paying fees of over £6,165 per annum full time rate.
- Financially assessed by Student Finance England (SFE) and to have provided consent to share between SFE and the University of Greenwich.
- Household income of £25,000 or less.
- Part-time students must be undertaking at least 60 credits in their first year of study Year 0 or 1.

Assessment and awarding process

- Assessment will be carried out automatically and a Aspire account will be generated automatically for eligible students.
- Shared data from the Student Finance portal will be used to filter out students whose household income is £25,000 or less.
- The assessment process for the first payment will be carried out from 3rd November 2025 for the September intake and 23rd February 2026 for the January intake.
- The assessment process for the second payment will be carried out from 9th February 2026 for the September intake and from 9th May 2025 for the January intake.
- The first payment will be paid to the students Aspire account by 8th December 2025 for the September intake and the 16th March 2026 for the January intake.
- The second payment will be paid to the students Aspire account by 16th March 2026 for the September intake and 8th of June 2026 for the January intake.
- Students will be contacted by the Student Finance and Financial Support Team to confirm their award.

Greenwich Bursary 2025-26 Eligibility and Payment Terms

- Part-time students will receive a payment of £350 paid in their first year of study only split into 2 instalments.
- To receive a second and/or final payment you must remain registered and in attendance on their programme.

Ineligible students

- PGCE students
- Pre Reg-Nursing students
- Sponsored students
- Studying Equivalent or Lower-Level Qualifications (ELQ)
- Direct Entry Students
- Direct Apprenticeship students
- Year 1 students that have completed year 0 at UGIC
