

Accessing Greenwich Inclusion Plans via Banner Web

The Greenwich Inclusion Plan (GIP) is a support plan which outlines the reasonable adjustments and arrangements that are needed for disabled students to be able to fully access their course with equity. Disabled students is an umbrella term for students with disabilities, neurodivergence, mental health condition and/or long-term medical condition. Disabled students need to be registered with the Student Wellbeing Service so that a GIP can be implemented.

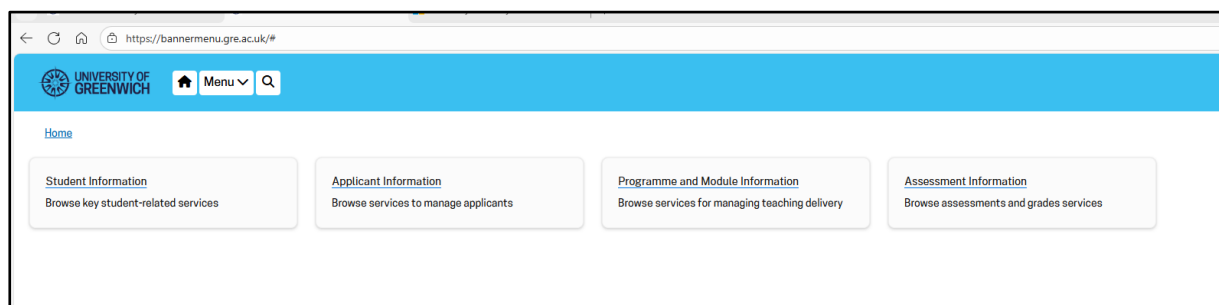
We have a duty under the Equality Act 2010 to consider and make adjustments; supporting students is an institutional responsibility and so you will need to view GIPs to ensure you are aware of your students' disability, their support needs and provide the reasonable adjustments and arrangements that are outlined on it. These arrangements include teaching, learning, exams, IT, library and teaching space arrangements.

To view a GIP

Upon creation of the GIP, you will receive an email notification with a link to the student's GIP. The link is personalised to the receiver and so cannot be shared and opened by other colleagues; this is due to confidentiality.

On Banner Web, you can view GIPs for all students attached to you.

To do this, open Banner Web via Staff Portal, click on 'Student Information', click on 'Greenwich Inclusion Plans', either scroll to the student you require or type in their Student ID in the search box, and then click on 'Details'.
